## A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF BEN HILL COUNTY, GEORGIA RECOGNIZING THE NEED TO CONTINUE COVID-19 PRECAUTIONS

**WHEREAS**, there exists a continued need for protecting the Ben Hill County citizens, especially the vulnerable populations;

**WHEREAS**, COVID-19 continually impacts every part of life: social distancing is still a necessity, a significant number of households have faced food and housing problems; and citizens require an enhanced level of service from first responders;

**WHEREAS**, Ben Hill County has launched and has continued major efforts to address the public health and economic impacts of the COVID-19 outbreak;

**WHEREAS**, both the public health and economic impacts of the COVID-19 outbreak have fallen more severely on disadvantaged communities and populations;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Commissioners of Ben Hill County that Ben Hill County will continue to aid the community suffering from the COVID-19 pandemic and will continue to implement safe practices to prevent the spread of COVID-19.
