**A RESOLUTION OF THE BEN HILL COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS TO
DECLARE PROPERTY SURPLUS AND TO SELL THE PROPERTY**

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners is authorized to declare property owned by the County as surplus when said property is deemed to be of no further use or value to same; and

WHEREAS, Deputy Thomas Register, a law enforcement officer for the Ben Hill County Sheriff's Office, has decided to resign from the Ben Hill County Sheriff's Office; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems that the following property is no longer needed and there is no projected future use of the property: a Glock 23, .40 Caliber, Serial Number GMX672, with three magazines carried by Deputy Thomas Register (the "Firearm"); and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners desires to sell the Firearm to Deputy Register pursuant to applicable Georgia and federal law for \$150.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Ben Hill County Board of Commissioners declares that the Firearm is surplus and no longer needed and hereby sells the Firearm to Deputy Register for \$150.00. Furthermore, the Board of Commissioners authorize Sheriff Lee Cone, County Manager Michael Dinnerman, or their designees to execute the necessary documents to effectuate the sale.
